

**CRC JUSTICE SUPPORT INFORMATION DISK
& PRE RELEASE PACKAGE**

In June 2000, Andrew Boulton (former Project Worker) presented the CRC Justice Support Information Package at the Annual AEVTI conference. At the Conference, it was asked that the participants think about how the Information package could be used in a Correctional setting. Some thought that it could be used a literacy / numeracy tool and others believed that it could be as an information tool for inmates' pre release. Present at the conference was Senior Education Officer for Berrima Correctional Centre, Col Beszants. Col Beszants decided that the Information Package could be utilised in the form of an Information Disk (designed similarly to a web page). Through consultation with Andrew Boulton, Col Beszants took the information back to Berrima and began developing the CRC Information Disk.

The disk, designed and developed by inmate Austin Hughes, comprises of the entire Information Package, however it has been divided separate links, making it easier to access for those who receive it. The Information Disk also includes the services the CRC Justice Support provides with a brief, yet a detailed summary of each of the projects. Also included is a copy of the Department of Fair Trading's Renters Guide, as it is referred to quite regularly in the disk. The Information disk has been distributed within Correctional Centres and diverse community-based organisations.
